## Change Leadership: the *people* side of change management

Change is coming at us faster and faster. The consulting firm Accenture recently released a report showing that the rate of change increased by 33% just in the last year alone.

Meanwhile, internal change initiatives often fail because of the emotions they evoke, usually because those emotions are glossed over or ignored.

When managers, leaders, and individuals understand the ways in which change creates uncertainty or anxiety *and* excitement and anticipation, they can help themselves and their teams participate actively in essential change initiatives - and avoid change fatigue and burnout.
